
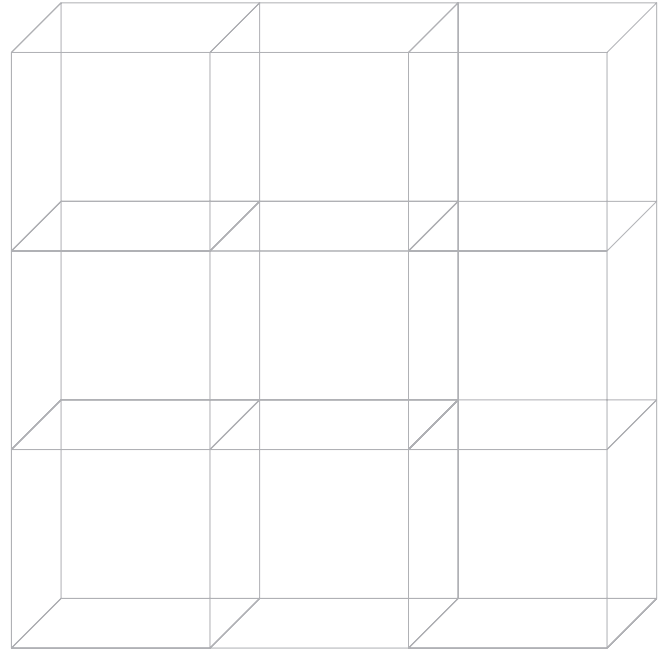


# Book Studies
