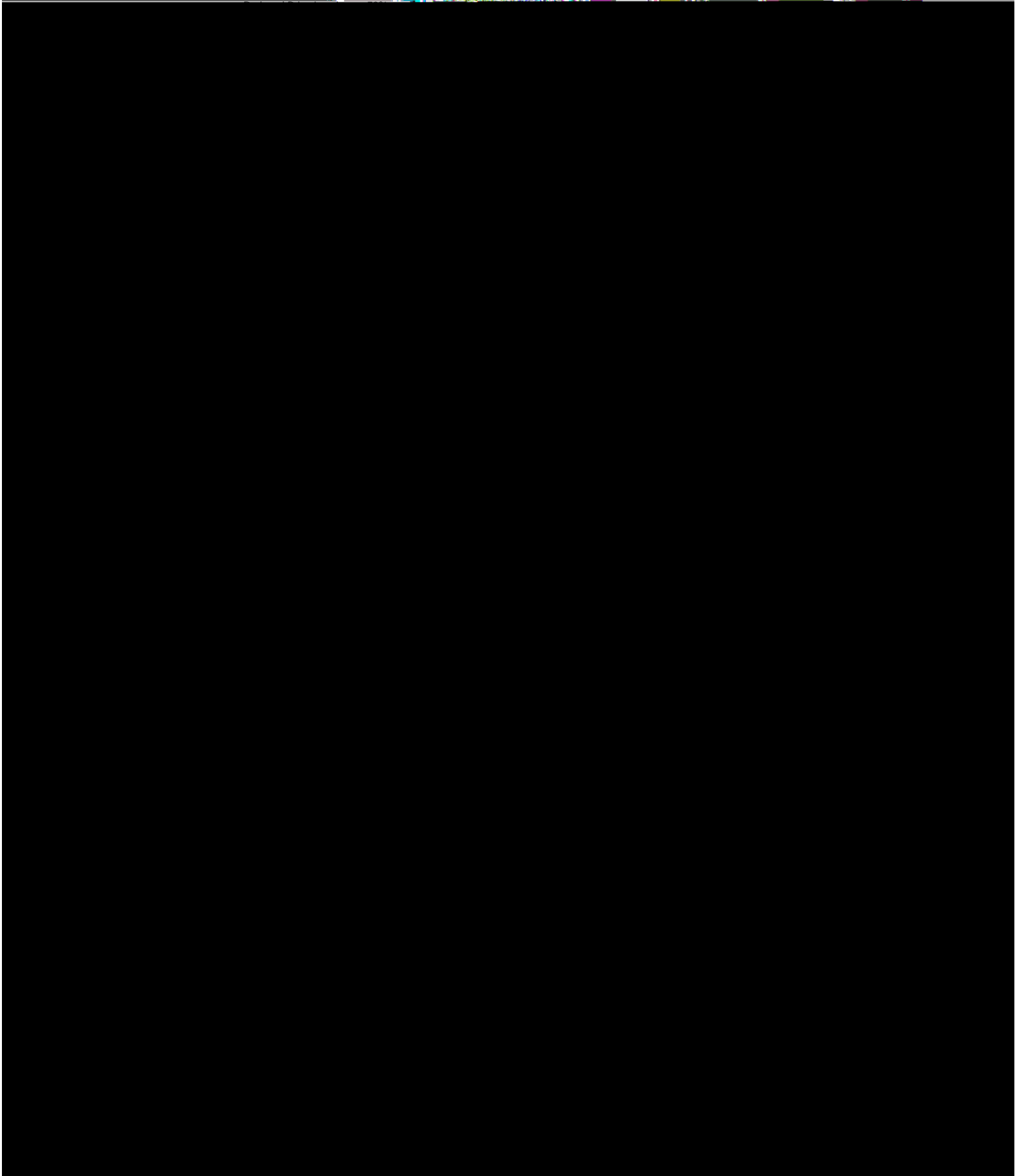


Lost River Elementary School; Bowling Green, KY
