- c. Now read the endings one at a time.
- First ending? (Signal.) -ack.
- Next ending? (Signal.) -eck.
- Next ending? (Signal.) -ick.
- Next ending? (Signal.) -ock.
- Next ending? (Signal.) -uck.
- d. (Call on individual students to read the endings.)
